Subject the 2020 pro forma budget

Because many of you are not on the HOA website,. We have attached the budget and highlighted pertinent information, <u>especially the 1<sup>st</sup> and last page indicating a potential large dues increase.</u>

## Currently

- \$15-20, 000 a month is paid in legal fees
- no restaurant income
- no office rental income
- offices still unfinished

## Additional money owed.

- \$10,000 owed the Bandinis
- \$8,000 owed the Bigelows
- \$3,000 owed the swim school
- \$8,000 owed Riggos Tree service
- \$16,000 owed the tennis pros

## After you review the attached budget it is suggested you also think about the questions listed below. Then ask questions of the entire board before this is passed.

- 1) Reserve allocation slashed to \$15,000 from \$30,000/month Two to three year needed per the reserve study suggested closer to \$40K monthly allocation is needed Yet the budget does not list that amount going into reserves.
- 2) Why are the proposed assessments more than double the current, (which is listed as \$161.50 not \$163.50) up to \$\$422/house? There is even a potential of \$250/ house
- 3) The budget proposes an 18% revenue increase via pool, restaurant, and an increase in the swim income rents. Yet we have no restaurant and money is owed to both the swim and tennis vendors.
- 4) No line item for the Sports Camp;
- 5) Administrative expenses expected to increase 32%. Payroll & associated costs to increase 12%.. It appears no amount has been expended for audit & bookkeeping in 2019. No financial statements being issued by an **Independent Third Party** (CPA);
- 6) Contracted Services to be reduced on a monthly basis from \$7,772.62 per month to \$4,785.00 per month. This reduction appears significant & will require further review on how these cost reductions can be achieved;

- 7) Maintenance Expenses to be reduced on a monthly basis from \$25,822.66 per month to \$10,964.50 per month. This reduction appears significant & will require further review on how these cost reductions can be achieved. Especially since Administrative costs and Payroll are increasing.
- 8) Are we getting revenue from the bench advertisements on the golf course and there is no listing for this on the budget?
- 9) No election services expense for 2020
- 10) Why are the greens and range fees and the pro shop reduced?
- 11) What media will cost \$3000?
